Additional Breeding Fees and Information

Cooled Semen:

Handling Fee: \$350.00 includes round-trip shipping and collection fee
\$50.00 additional for Saturday delivery
Container Deposit: \$350.00 secured with credit card - not charged unless container is damaged or not returned.

Frozen Semen:

Frozen semen is handled by [Select Breeders Service Inc.](#) If you are breeding with frozen semen, additional information and fee schedule is available online at the above link or you can request a package mailed to you.

10% Discounts for:

Premium Mares - must provide proof of premium status for breeding.
Mares that have produced a minimum of 3 premium foals (proof required)
Multiple mares
Return breeding – the same year of foaling
Performance mares with qualifying scores in FEI level dressage and upper level jumping and hunter.

Collection Schedule for Cooled Semen:

Semen is collected on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from March 1 thru August 31. We will try to accommodate the breeder when possible. The breeder must contact Lost World Farms, LLC by noon the day before to guarantee shipment. Keep us aware of your mare's progress by informing us when she enters the heat you are planning to breed. **CONTACT US BY PHONE ONLY – DO NOT USE FAX OR E-MAIL FOR SEMEN REQUESTS!**

Preparing the Mare:

Barren and non maiden mares must have a culture prior to breeding and it is recommended that all mares have a pre-breeding exam at least one month prior to breeding to insure that she is in sound breeding condition.

Confirming Pregnancy:

The following schedule is recommended to confirm your mare's pregnancy:

Day 14-16: To confirm pregnancy and check for twins, if no pregnancy you have time to prepare for re-breeding on next heat.

Day 28: To check for heartbeat and reconfirm pregnancy.

Day 35-40: To confirm maintained pregnancy.

Day 60-65: Final conformation of pregnancy.

Registering the Foal:

Patrick is approved for breeding in the ISR/Oldenburg NA breed registry. Mares that are registered in most of the Warmblood registries, the Jockey Club, and Arabian Horse Registry are eligible for approval (see www.isroldenburg.org). It is recommended that the mare be approved prior to breeding, but it is acceptable to have the mare and foal inspected at the same time. We do not require that you register your foal, but we strongly recommend that you do. It provides proof of parentage, future breeding options, and better marketability of the foal.
